


### In 2022, we saw the impact more than ever before:

- We served more than 300 students the largest ever in the B.E.S.T. organization in one year
- We had our most significant number of students matriculating into medical school (6)
- We saw an 18-point increase in the science scores of our 5<sup>th</sup> graders at Dunbar Elementary Magnet School

Our partnership with the 7<sup>th</sup> largest school system in the U.S., Hillsborough County School District, has contributed to our success in a huge way. We want to capitalize on the framework we have created to bring these concepts to other districts locally and nationally. We established a medical clinic birthed out of our Social Determinants program, serving East and West Tampa citizens. We also received grants from the state and local medical entities, including two of our local professional sports teams. AARP has been instrumental in supporting us as we expand our mission. We look forward to building and growing our capacity to reach more students who aspire to become medical professionals.
